



Noise Action Week is an annual initiative coordinated by Environmental Protection UK, which aims to raise awareness of the problems caused by neighbourhood noise and the solutions available to tackle it. It provides an opportunity for local authorities, housing providers, mediation services and all those involved in neighbour noise management to raise awareness of services available and promote practical solutions.

Noise Action Week 2010 coincides with International Noise Awareness Day (28 April), so there has never been a better time to raise the profile of noise.

During Noise Action Week hundreds of organisations involved in managing noise across the UK, including local authority noise, housing, health teams, antisocial behaviour teams, housing organisations, mediation services, schools and others, coordinate events at local level to educate and inform people about noise, the impact it has and how to reduce it.

Key issues will include:

- * Student noise and how to deal with it
- * Licencing and licensed premises
- * Headphones and hearing
- * Noise at work
- * Noise from tenants

Noise Action Week gives everyone involved in managing noise problems the opportunity to focus public and media attention on the problems excessive noise can cause.
