

Improving Economy? Improving Environment? Keeping the environment at the forefront of the economic recovery

A one day national conference to consider ways of ensuring that environmental protection is strengthened as the UK economy recovers.

There are now strong signs of a recovery in the UK economy. However, the finances of bodies responsible for environmental protection, including local authorities and statutory agencies remain under severe pressure with further cuts to come. These cuts and the pressure that comes from developers and industries to cut red tape, threaten the framework of regulation and active management that protects the environment. There are, however, opportunities from the recovery and the availability of new green technology to strengthen environmental protection and to ensure the improvement of the environment in line with the growth of economic activity.

The Autumn Conference will focus on the challenges and opportunities for EPUK, its members and partner organisations as they work to ensure that the economic recovery is matched by environmental improvement in the context of continuing austerity measures. There will be keynote talks and expert presentations with special sessions for each of the main EPUK topics, air quality, land quality and noise. The programme is planned to ensure that there will be improved opportunities for discussion in the conference sessions with ample opportunities for networking and for viewing the exhibition.

In particular there will be updates on:

- Government's priorities for environmental protection and sustainable development
- Current issues for Local Authorities and others addressing the challenges of contaminated land
- The emerging debate on fracking and the extent of our knowledge of the effects on the environment
- Opportunities for Local Authorities with new responsibilities in environment and public health
- Local Air Quality Management, Nitrogen dioxide and EU infringement fines
- Action on Noise and Health

- Local authority Environmental Health Practitioners, Contaminated Land, Planning and Transport Officers
- Elected members with an environment brief or interest
- Environmental managers from the private and public sectors
- Environmental businesses and consultants, monitoring and other equipment manufacturers
